Prescription drug coverage	Not all prescription medications are covered by CareLink.	✓ Prescription medications filled at University Health pharmacies are covered.*
Ambulance services	✗	✓ Ambulance services are covered for emergency medical transportation.*
Hearing aids	✗	✓ Hearing aids are covered (one hearing aid per ear every 36 months).
Vision care	✗	✓ For your dependents - annual children's eye exam and one pair of glasses per year are covered.*
Durable Medical Equipment	Some items not covered.	✓ Durable Medical Equipment is covered with prior authorization from the plan.
Chiropractic care	✗	✓ 35 chiropractic visits covered per year.* No pre-authorization required.
Hospice care	✗	✓ Hospice care is covered for Members with a terminal illness. Services include bereavement counseling.*

COVERAGE EXAMPLES

As a UCCP Member, you will experience cost savings when using your health care coverage. Some services may require a copay or coinsurance. **After your copay or coinsurance is paid, you owe nothing.** Here are a few examples of what you might pay for certain health care services as a CareLink vs. UCCP Member.

Ambulance Service	Not covered by CareLink (\$400-\$1,000)	\$150 copay*
Emergency Room Care	\$1,000-\$2,000	\$150 copay*
Diagnostic Test (X-ray)	\$250	\$80 copay*
Durable Medical Equipment (Crutches)	Not covered by CareLink (\$50-\$200)	\$40 copay*
Follow Up with a Specialist	\$175	\$40 copay*
Estimated Total Cost	\$1,875 - \$3,625	\$460

You think you have diabetes.	CARELINK	UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY CARE PLAN
Specialist Office Visit	\$200	\$40 copay*
Diagnostic Test (Blood Work)	\$400	\$80 copay*
Prescription Drugs	\$10-\$20/prescription	\$10-\$40 copay/prescription*
Follow-up Visit	\$175	\$40 copay*
Estimated Total Cost	\$785-795	\$155-\$200

You struggle with neck pain.	CARELINK	UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY CARE PLAN
Chiropractic Visits (5 Visits)	Not covered by CareLink (\$150-\$250/visit)	\$40 copay/visit* (up to 35 visits allowed per year)
Estimated Total Cost	\$750-\$1,250	\$200
